Call to Order: 08:45 by Dave KB7GFL

Introductions: 13 in attendance and 2 guests (Mike Rubino & David Fine)

Secretary/Treasurers Report: \$869.09 in bank account, \$64 in petty cash (\$29 from 50/50)

Repeater Status / Net Report: 70cm – op reported good with new repeater/controller, now at W7BCW's work shop using clubs ground plane antenna; 2m link – op and reports of good signals using new link rig; APRS – reports of hearing but cannot connect to; 6m – from others report that it is op; NET @ 19:30 hours every Tuesday status by Cybyl N6IBI averaging 6 check in's for November so far. Bruce W7BCW talked about getting quotes for the repeater transmission line replacement and 2 quotes were returned from 2 vendors.
