Repeater Status / Net Report: 70cm – repaired (found cracked chip cap on final PA transistor output) and setup at W7BCW QTH for now; 2m link – not active due to interface cable still in cabinet at repeater site; APRS – station is set for beacon plus digipeater use only and is working Ok; 6m – ID'ing only appears no RX; NET @ 19:30 hours every Tuesday status averaging 7 -8 check in's for Nov. 2019 – Dec. 2019 so far. New Business: Bruce W7BCW purchased a new duplexer for the 70 cm repeater and has it installed along with the repeater at his QTH plus he installed a new Comet GP-6 ground plane antenna (same model used at clubs repeater site on water tank) that has some gain to help with access from long distance stations. Bruce W7BCW thanked Eric K7QOG for the donation of an Icom IC-4020 repeater as a spare when the clubs DR-1X has problems.

Tom K8TOM talked about upcoming presentations on WinLink in Feb. 2020 meeting and APRS date to be determined plus downloading YouTube videos on topics of interest to club members that can be played back during Club Meetings.
