



Executive meeting of the Sky Valley A.R.C. May 2nd 1999

Meeting called to order by Matt Kula KJ7HS President. Also in attendance were Vice President Ray Ubis KG7UB and his wife Vicky, Treasurer Bernice Powell WB7ALA, and her husband Tom, Secretary Robin Lewis WA7YOQ, and last but not least our member at large Dan Morris N7ENE.

The President asked the Treasurer for the bank balance, which she reported as being \$824.96 with a deposit yet to be made.

Matt then brought up his first topic for discussion the 6-meter Repeater at Mt. Index, is temporarily installed at the shack after a little trouble with the coax connectors. They did get it up and running on the test day, just a little later than they thought. The receiver is up and installed the coax run. The transmitter antenna is tuned but not up. The door is on hinges and framed in but still needs a door latch/lock. The shack itself has partial insulation and roofing felt installed. A small work party should be able to finish up the inside work relatively quickly. Mike has some plywood for the walls and we need to clean up the weeds around the shack.

Next was the 70-cm project. We still haven't talked to Bill about the City of Sultans participation. We have an antenna, low loss hardline with connectors. We also have a skeleton slot dual yagi beam, which might prove to be a good link antenna, but it needs to be tested. There is a note to ask Dave about some hardline 100-200 feet.

The President submitted to the bank the new form with the change of officers listed for accounting purposes. President Matt Kula KJ7HS, Vice-President Ray Ubis KG7UB, Secretary Robin Lewis WA7YOQ, Treasurer Bernice Powell WB7ALA and our two Members at Large Gary Lewis WA7BBJ and Dan Morris N7ENE. He also submitted the paperwork on the nonprofit status of the club to the State of Washington.

Then we broke for dinner. Matt asked the secretary to please bring him the black book and assorted software and he will resume doing the static.

Resuming the meeting after dinner.

Keeping in mind that the slab size we have to work with is 12x12 Home depot had a variety of options that Ray Ubis reported on. The Chelsea at \$560.00 the Elite at \$480.00 and the Regent at \$388.00 all of the above are wood structures.

Matt will check on the possibility of buying a quarter or a half of a steel-shipping container. Would they deliver? Check size and weight.
